Biodiversity Policy

Chineham Park is committed to the principles of environmental protection and sustainable development with the aim of reducing its environmental impact.

We understand the growing importance of ecology and biodiversity in the built environment. And in line with MAPP and Frasers Properties policies Chineham Park commits to:

1. Comply with relevant legislation and statutory codes of practice.
2. Assess the biodiversity implications of new or emerging legislation to ensure that business operations align with new standards.
3. Conserve and enhance biodiverse habitats within and close to our communities to benefit our tenants, residents and the environment.
4. Plan and manage our grounds and landscape activities to avoid negative impacts to biodiversity and to, wherever possible, promote biodiversity enhancements.

6. Promote health and wellbeing through engagement in nature-based activities.
7. Promote the use of landscaping features to provide a range of ecosystem services such as carbon storage, sustainable drainage, noise reduction, air quality as well as a biodiversity benefit.
